Hi Ben,

I want to voice my concern over the proposed restrictions on limits of poultry and on-site processing.

The 4-6 bird (hens only) restriction effectively cancels roadside egg selling.

Who will put out only two dozen (after family use) eggs at their roadside stand once a week? Thats a lot of work for a pittance return.

Additionally, the raising and processing of meat birds for personal use would be prohibited. It will be impossible to find a commercial processor who would process six or fewer birds for an individual.

It is grossly unfair to disallow people to grow and process their own food.

Wouldn't that also infringe on our Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms, to deny citizens the right to grow their own food ?
