Hi Ian and Legislative Services,

I'm writing to provide feedback on Zoning Bylaw 4710, specifically in regard to chickens. I know you're probably all getting a lot of emails about chickens right now.

My issue is that my zoning, R-3, provides me up to 6 hens. No roosters. And no meat hens due to no on-site slaughtering.

I believe this is unreasonable and an overstep, particularly given prevailing food security and pricing concerns.

Moreover, I'd like to suggest that the zoning on my property does not seem fit for purpose. I'm on 5 acres, and Honeymoon Bay is a rural area. Less than 20% of my property line is even bordering any neighbours, yet I'm confined to what is pitched as a 'small' residential lot zoning.

I welcome your input on this and thank you for your work so far in ensuring that the community is heard.
