I'm writing to share my support for Drifters Creamery and other small food-truck businesses that help make Cobble Hill a lively, welcoming community.

The proposed changes to section 4.14 of the Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw—especially limiting vending to 8 hours per day and requiring trucks to be removed after each period—could unintentionally discourage the very local businesses that draw people into our area.

Food trucks create gathering places, support local events, and bring more residents and visitors into Cobble Hill. Flexible, supportive rules would help these small operators continue contributing to a vibrant, people-oriented community.

I hope you'll consider adjustments that allow food trucks like Drifters Creamery to keep serving and strengthening our local economy.
